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Based on the Approval of the AICTE, permission from the Government of Andhra Pradesh and on the recommendations of the University Inspection Committee, Sanction is hereby accorded for the grant of extension of Provisional Affiliation to **Nishitha Degree College, Nizamabad** to offer **M.B.A** Course with an intake of **(180)** students only for the Academic year 2021-22. The college has to fulfill the following conditions/deficiencies pointed out by the University Inspection Committee and also general rules of affiliation of Telangana University:

Specific Conditions:

1. Prescribed books worth Rs.50, 000/-
2. 10 International and 5 National Journals to be procured.
3. 2 Lecturers to be appointed through duly constituted selection committee.

General Rules of Affiliation:

1. The following land and building requirements to be fulfilled before 31st December 2022 as per AICTE Norms:
 1. Building Requirements:
 - a. Separate, Own Pucca Building with 21380 sq.ft for 120 students
 - b. Building should be in the name of society or trust and not in individual. It's to be Owned and not on Lease.
 - c. No other educational activity should be carried out in the building which is meant for MBA Course.
 2. Land Requirement
 - a. The institution should possess 1.0 acre of exclusive well demarcated land for the intake of above strength.
 - b. Title deed should be in the name of institution/trust and not in the name of any individuals. It is to be owned and not on lease
2. Purchase books worth Rs.50000/ for the academic year 2021-22.
3. It is mandatory to install CC Camera and Biometric for both Staff and Students
4. Fire safety certificate should be obtained from fire services department for college building
5. Staff Approval/renewal before 16th September 2022.
6. Issue the appointment orders to the teachers before 24th September 2022

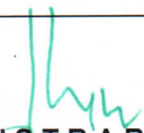
7. All the Governing Body meetings should be conducted for each academic year by associating University Representative as the Governing body Member and submit duly filed Governing Body meeting minutes proforma for details and decision of Governing Body meeting and submit it to the office of the Directorate of Academic Audit, TU on the same day of meeting or the very next day without fail.
 - i) First Governing Body meeting should be conducted in the month of April, 2022.
 - ii) Second Governing Body meeting should be conducted in the month of July, 2022.
 - iii) Third Governing Body meeting should be conducted in the month of November, 2022.
8. Teaching Diaries, Student Attendance Registers, Staff Attendance Registers, Acquaintance Registers, Stock Registers and Accession Registers are to be maintained as per norms and are to be signed and stamped by the Governing Body member during the Governing Body Meeting.
9. Salaries to the staff should be paid through bank A/c payee/online, deduct professional tax and submit Form-16 to IT Department.
10. Provide Girls Waiting Room with Toilets
11. Provide potable water to all the students each floor.
12. Arrange electrical lights and fans in each class room and lab
13. The college should approach the University 15 days before expiry of the term of the Governing Body Members.
14. The college should display the College name Board prominently along with the details of the college Full Address, phone Numbers, Website, Email-ID and its affiliation status to Telangana university.
15. The college should have a website and Email-ID, Skype ID and webcam with Headphones.
16. Teaching staff information to be uploaded online in faculty management system at College Logins.

The Management is therefore directed to submit the Compliance Report on the fulfillment of the above deficiencies along with necessary documentary evidence on or before **30.04.2022** through the Principal of the College in the following format without fail.

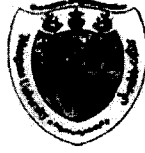

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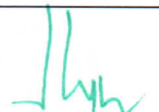
